



2024 Rule Reminder

Qualification

- Qualify by gaining three scores of over 60% between 1st January and 31 August at each level you wish to attend. If competing at the Side Saddle Championships – these must be done side saddle.
- You can qualify for these Championships on a BD class ticket or Club/Full Membership.
- If you and your horse are eligible for any of the other championships, you can qualify for others with the same three scores.



Associations

- For breed classes, horses must have evidence of breeding on passport. Part-bred classes are open to those with a minimum of 12.5% blood. TGCA horses/ponies must be approved and over stamped by the TGCA.



Championships

- You can compete at a maximum of two consecutive levels at each championship. For example, you could compete Prelim and Novice at the Side Saddle Championship and Novice and Elementary at the Draught Championship, but not all three at Side Saddle.
- Previous Championship winners are not allowed to compete at the same level/championship. Apart from Veteran Horses (all levels) and all championships at Medium or above.
- Introductory Championships are held in a 40m x 20m. Preliminary to Prix St Georges are held in 60m x 20m.
- Commanders are not permitted at the Championships.
- Whips are not permitted at the Championships (excluding side saddle riders).
- You and your horse must be full BD members to compete at the Championships. Excluding Introductory combinations – they must hold a Club membership.
- **Championships held at Onley Grounds Equestrian Centre on the 22 – 26 October 2024.**
