Class 1 Lead Rein Equitation

Competitors will enter the Arena at A and give a **Freestyle Show not exceeding 3 minutes timed from initial halt to final halt and salute**. The freestyle show must include Walk and Trot on both reins. Competitors will leave the Arena at A..

The judge will assess the correctness of the rider's position and the influence on the horse/pony's way of going and the stability and balance of the saddle

Horse/pony must lead on a loose rein and not be unduly influenced by the leader

Class 2 Newcomers Equitation

Open to Competitors who have not previously been placed in the first six in any Novice, Intermediate or Open Equitation or the first three in Newcomers, Cygnet or Young Rider classes at the National Side Saddle Shows. **Ridden in a 20m x 40m dressage arena**

Competitors will enter the Arena at A and give a **Freestyle Show not exceeding 3 minutes timed from initial halt to final halt and salute**. The freestyle show must include Walk, Trot and Canter on both reins. Competitors will leave the Arena at A..

The judge will assess the correctness of the rider's position and the influence on the horse/pony's way of going and the stability and balance of the saddle.

Class 3 CYGNET EQUITATION

Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Cygnet Test.

Ridden in a 20m x 40m dressage arena

Open to Lead Rein and Non-Lead Rein Junior members who have attained their 5th but not their 9th birthday on 1st January 2022.

Class 4 YOUNG RIDER NOVICE EQUITATION

Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Young Rider Test.

Ridden in a 20m x 40m dressage arena

Open to members aged under 14 on 1st January 2022 of the current year

Class 5 JUNIOR NOVICE EQUITATION

Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Junior Novice Test.

Ridden in a 20m x 40m dressage arena

Rider must not have been placed 1st or 2nd in a Novice Equitation class at the last 3 National Equitation Championship Shows.

Class 6 YOUNG RIDER OPEN EQUITATION

Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Young Rider Test.

Ridden in a 20m x 60m dressage arena

Open to members aged under 14 on 1st January 2022 of the current year

Ridden in a 20m x 40m dressage arena

Class 7 JUNIOR OPEN EQUITATION

Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Junior Open Test.

Ridden in a 20m x 60m dressage arena

Open to all riders Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Junior Open Equitation Test.

Class 8 ADULT NOVICE EQUITATION

Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Adult Novice Test.

Ridden in a 20m x 40m dressage arena

Rider must not have:

- been placed 1st or 2nd in a Novice Equitation class at the last 3 National Equitation Championship Shows..
- been placed in the first six in an Intermediate Equitation class at the last 3 National Equitation Championship Shows.
- competed in an Open Equitation class at the last 3 National Equitation Championship Shows..

Class 9 ADULT INTERMEDIATE EQUITATION

Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Adult Intermediate Test.

Ridden in a 20m x 60m dressage arena

- been placed 1st or 2nd in an Intermediate Equitation class at the last 3 National Equitation Championship Shows.
- been placed in the first six in an Open Equitation class at the last 3 National Equitation Championship Shows.

Class 10 ADULT OPEN EQUITATION

Competitors to ride the SSA 2022 Adult Open Test.

Ridden in a 20m x 60m dressage arena

Class 11 JUMPCOACH
