The workshop is planned to share thoughts and ideas, educate and develop the skills and knowledge of side saddle specialist saddlers in order to enable us to work together in partnership for the future development of side saddle riding. The emphasis of the day will be on the practical fitting of a side saddle for the welfare of the horse and stability and positioning of the rider. Focus will be hands on participation and interaction, so participants will need to bring a basic toolkit with them. Once the session has commenced, times are a guide. The end of day timing is approximate and will be extended if needed. Please note most of the day will be in the indoor school so dress appropriately.

9.45 Working in groups: Assessment and observation of horses and riders and identification of corrective actions required followed by practical application working on saddles.

Gather case history, evaluate horses statically and in hand, assess horse & rider using astride saddle and then side saddle, consider horses' level of education, established way of going and rider's level of ability. Society of Master Saddlers recommended procedure will be observed for this section. Discussion and subsequent practical action will focus on:

- Side saddle balance and its effect for the riders position, security and comfort.
- Side saddle balance and its effect on the horses comfort and welfare.
- Factors that may affect fitting
- Quick fixes and/or long term solutions.
