### **Saturday, May 28th**

**11h** : arrival of all competitors at the tent "Accueil Concours"

Declaration of the teams for the Coupe des Nations, engagements, stabling, etc...

**13h 30 – 17h30** : dressage :

- Free style to music Club 2 and 3 13 euros
- Free style to music Club 1 13 euros
- Amateur 3 - C 15 euros
- Amateur 2 - B 15 euros

**18hrs** : prizes and rewards ceremony for the day's competition

**20h** : "Le Pontet"

Agility jumping course (horses and ponies jump: two classes : (N1 or N2) 12 euros

After the relay jumping course, the evening will continue with dancing and watching the DVD of last year's Europ Amazones on a large screen.

**8.30hr – 12h** : dressage :

**12.30hrs** : prizes and rewards ceremony of the morning competitions

**13h 15 – 14h 45** : "Le Pontet"

Costume class competition : 2 classes : above 20 years of age and under.

Three categories Fantasy, Historical and Tradition 5 euros

**15h** : Derby : 7 à 9 jumping obstacles followed by cross country

(horses and ponies : 2 classes : N1 or N2) 12 euros

**17h** : prizes and rewards ceremony of the afternoon competitions

**Prizes will be given at the end of each half day at the tent "Accueil Concours"**

**Music for the free style tests must be given on CDs.**

**Relay jumping course** : N1 = 1metre and N2 = 0,80 metre

Teams of 2 riders enter a Relay Course, including 4 show jumping obstacles, with chronometer.

The results will be calculated with the penalties and chronometer of each team.

**Costume Class** : Category : fantasy, historical and tradition

A rider can only compete in one and only category.

2 classes : above 20 years of age, and under 20 years of age.

Presentation and marks given on the imposed Amazones de France Elegance test.

The test itself must not exceed 3minutes30, but the time of occupation of the arena can go up to 5 minutes.

**Derby** : N1 = 1m – N2 = 0,80m

Show jumping 8 jumps (A chronometer) then cross country 1.100 metres

Entries for the dressage tests, for the relay jumping course, costume class and derby must be sent to the organising committee “Le Lion Equestre”, address below, by **Monday 23 May 18hrs.**
