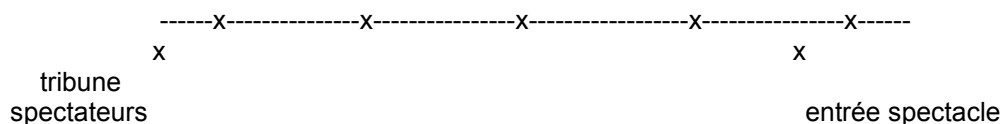
8th Scene 1950 - Bettina Keil will present a KUR – wearing Side Saddle Association habits)

The music should be on a CD preferably 2 copies in case one gets lost or deteriorated. About 700 people are expected to attend.

Entries for the tests should be made by 24th May. So please either direct with Catherine Hislam for all the riders in England, and with me for Bettina. Same applies for requested stabling (see next paragraph).

Stabling :

Mr. Boutolleau will charge half rate for the stabling 38€ : 2 = **19€ per night**. (However he very much hopes that, if the show proves to be a success, he will not charge for stabling. But he just cannot confirm this at present.)

You will all have as much straw as needed. However those who need shavings should please bring their own, because regrettably none is available at the Stud.

Please ask for number of nights you require stabling by 24 May specifying the sex of your horse, whether stallion, time and date of arrival, time and date of departure.

All competitors will have 3 meal vouchers (one for Friday evening, one for Saturday evening and one for Sunday lunch).

Rehearsal of the Show is scheduled during the evening of Friday 28th May at 6 pm

COUPE DES NATIONS – RULES

Each country will be represented by a team of 4 side saddle riders, one of which will be the leader.

The name of the leader should be given before 24th May.

The team will be composed by 4 riders each taking part in different levels of the competition. There will be no entry fee.

One couple entering Freestyle and Amateur 2

One couple entering Freestyle and Amateur 3

One couple entering Freestyle and Club 1

One couple entering Freestyle and Club 2

The team leader should inform the Organising Committee on Saturday 29th May at the 11.30hrs meeting of the names of each couple of his team.

Results will be obtained with the results of each 4 couples of a same team. The team obtaining the highest mark will be declared the winner, and so on.

Results will be given at 05.00pm. All nations should be present. Only the first 3 nations will receive a prize. Every team leader must appear before its team, also during the results.

The 3 first nations should have 4 grooms ready to accompany.

After the results have been given, 2 tours of honour will be made by the 3 first nations, and one last one for the winner.
