AFFILIATING CORRECTLY

In order to be correctly affiliated,
Show Secretaries **ARE REQUESTED TO** observe the following rules

1. **Completed Affiliation Forms and the correct fee must be received by the Side Saddle Association, by 1st February, 2012.**
2. **A copy of the relevant section of draft schedule MUST be sent to Mrs. L Gambling, S.S.A. Show Affiliations, for approval. Until the draft is received AND approved, NO rosettes will be sent to you. Please ensure the wording for all classes conform to those given in this Guide.**
3. **If your Judge's name was not included on the affiliation form, it should be included on the draft schedule or forwarded as soon as possible and in advance of your Show.**
4. **A copy of the final schedule should also be forwarded.**

INFORMATION FOR SECRETARIES OF ALL AFFILIATING SHOWS

A. COMPETITION RULES

FALLS: A fall of horse/pony or rider in any class run under Side Saddle Association rules will result in disqualification, and the rider must leave the ring dismounted. It is strongly recommended that medical advice is then sought before competing in any other class.

JUNIORS: Competitors **MUST** have attained their 5th birthday but be under 16 on 1st January of the current year and wear a hat to current British Safety standards or above, in ALL classes affiliated to or run by the S.S.A. A Spur or Spur band is not permitted in any class where jumping is involved.

ADULTS: Adult competitors must wear a hat to current British Safety Standard or above where indicated in the Competition Rules. Where safety hats are not compulsory, Adult competitors wear alternative headgear at their own risk.

LEAD REIN competitors **MUST** compete **Hors Concours** in any S.S.A. affiliated class unless otherwise stated.

QUALIFIERS: Shows held up to and including the first day of the 2012 National Side Saddle Show will be Qualifiers for 2012. Shows held after that date will be Qualifiers for the following year.

B. JUDGES:

S.S.A. Panel Judges are listed on pages 7 to 10 and the back cover of this booklet.

C. MARK SHEETS, ETC.

Results and/or mark sheets are provided by the S.S.A. for all Equitation, Equitation Jumping, Classical Ladies Side Saddle Class, Working Hunter and WHP classes.

D. JUMPING CLASSES

Side saddle jumping classes are a crowd-puller and exceptionally popular. Shows wishing to offer them are invited to discuss the range of classes with their Area Chairman. You are asked, **IN THE INTERESTS OF SAFETY**, to request an S.S.A. representative to walk and approve the course. All courses should be designed to encourage.

E. ROSETTES PROVIDED BY THE S.S.A.

Please note that these Rosettes are additional to and do not replace a Show's own place rosettes:

The Side Saddle Association Equitation Classes:

2 sets, 1st to 3rd places

1 rosette for the Best Turned Out Adult

1 rosette for the Best Turned Out Junior Member

1 rosette for the Highest Placed Member under 12 on 1st January of the current year

If applicable, Sir Lancelot: 1 special rosette

Classical Ladies:

2 special rosettes.

Working Hunter, WHP and Equitation Jumping Classes:

1 rosette for each Class

Concours d'Élégance:

3 special rosettes.

Costume Concours d'Élégance, Side Saddle Riding Club Horse/Pony, Best Horse or Pony to be ridden Side Saddle:

2 rosettes for each class

Additional Special Rosettes:

S.S.A. rosettes are available for Shows to purchase and award to the highest placed S.S.A. Member, carrying their current Championship Points Card, riding side saddle in such classes as, Ladies Hunter, Ladies Hack, Side Saddle Show Pony, etc.

EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFYING CLASSES

may be offered as

OPTION 1, an Open Class, open to Adults and Juniors. If entries warrant, an Open Class may be divided into an Adult and a Junior Class at the discretion of the Show. S.S.A. Rosettes and Qualifying Points shall be awarded to Adults & Juniors as 2 sections: the highest placed Adult & Junior competitors will receive S.S.A. rosettes to 3rd place, and Qualifying Points down each line. The highest placed Member under 12 on 1st January of the current year will receive a rosette.

or OPTION 2, two classes, Adult and Junior, with the same rosettes as Option 1.

- The Judge must be on the current S.S.A. Judging Panel
- Shows held up to and including the first day of the 2012 National Side Saddle Show will be Qualifiers for 2012. Shows held after that date will be Qualifiers for the following year.
- In all equitation classes it is the rider and not the horse that is judged and qualifies and there will be no reference to the sex, breeding or conformation of the horse. However, horses should, in the opinion of the judge, have manners suitable for carrying a side saddle. Horses shall be 4 years old or over.
- Competitors enter the ring together and are required by the Judge to walk, trot and canter on the right rein, followed by a change of rein through trot and canter left, before being called into a provisional order.
- Each competitor is asked to give a freestyle show to a maximum of 2 minutes, after which the competitor's saddle and turnout is inspected after their individual show.

CLASS WORDING FOR OPTION 1

✦ The Side Saddle Association EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS OPEN QUALIFYING CLASS

Run under S.S.A. Rules defined in the current Member's Handbook. Open to S.S.A. Members and Non-Members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for S.S.A. rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and S.S.A. Championship Points. **Southernden Farm** offers a rosette to the highest placed Member under 12 on 1st January of the current year. **Side Saddle International** offer a rosette to the Adult Member and **Manor Grange Stud Show Centre** to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out.

OR CLASS WORDING FOR OPTION 2

The Side Saddle Association EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS ADULT QUALIFYING CLASS

Run under S.S.A. rules defined in the current Members' Handbook. Open to S.S.A. Adult Members and Non-Members aged 16 or over on 1st January of the current year. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for S.S.A. rosettes to 3rd place and S.S.A. Championship Points. **Side Saddle International** offer a rosette to the Adult Member, judged to be the best turned out.

✦ The Side Saddle Association EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS JUNIOR QUALIFYING CLASS

Run under S.S.A. rules defined in the current Members' Handbook. Open to S.S.A. Junior Members and Non-Members aged under 16 on 1st January of the current year. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for S.S.A. rosettes to 3rd place and S.S.A. Championship Points. **Southernden Farm** offers a rosette to the highest placed Member under 12 on 1st January of the current year. **Manor Grange Stud Show Centre** offer a rosette to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out.

QUALIFIER FOR THE SIR LANCELOT MEMORIAL TROPHY

- For Shows (maximum of 2 per S.S.A. Area), invited by the relevant S.S.A. Area Chairman, to hold a Sir Lancelot Qualifier.
- The Judge must be on the current S.S.A. Panel but may be assisted by a Celebrity or Sponsor

A Special rosette will be offered to the Adult Member, carrying their current Championship Points Card, of the **S.S.A. Area in which the Show is organised**, who during the Equitation Class (irrespective of final placing) is judged to be the most elegant. That member will be eligible to compete in the Final for the Sir Lancelot Memorial Trophy (donated by the late Mrs E. Skelton) at the National Side Saddle Show. A Member may only qualify once per season between one National Show and the next, and if the Judge's first choice has already qualified, the rosette will be awarded to the next eligible competitor.

CLASSICAL LADIES SIDE SADDLE QUALIFIER

- The Judge must be on the current S.S.A., SHBGB, BSHA, BSPS, or P(UK) Judging Panels
- Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided

✦ The Side Saddle Association CLASSICAL LADIES SIDE SADDLE QUALIFYING CLASS

Open to S.S.A. Members and Non-members, aged 16 and over on January 1st of the current year, riding side saddle, on horses exceeding 148cms (14.2hh). To be judged 25% conformation and action, 25% manners & way of going, 25% rider, and 25% turnout of horse & rider, by a SHBGB, BSHA, BSPS, P(UK) or SSA Panel Judge. Judges may request a short show, but will not ride exhibits; horses will not be stripped. Traditional habits must be worn. Fancy Dress and Period Costumes NOT permitted. **N.B.** Silk hats are permitted to be worn in this class AT ANY TIME OF THE DAY. Judges are requested to use the mark sheet provided. The highest placed horse/rider combination qualifies for the Final to be held at the National Side Saddle Show. In the event of previous qualification, this may be passed down to fourth place. Special rosettes are offered by **Dr. K. Milbourne and Mrs. J. Timperley** to the winner and if the winner has already qualified awarded a second rosette is awarded with the qualification card. Qualifying combinations are required to become Full Members of the S.S.A. 21 days prior to the National Side Saddle Show to be eligible to compete at the Final.

- *The Judge must be on the current S.S.A. or other appropriate Judging Panels*

SIDE SADDLE RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY OPEN CLASS

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over. Riders will be required to give a short show including a small jump, maximum 61cms (2'). The height may be adjusted during the course of the class at the Judge's discretion. The class shall be judged on the show, the manners of horse/pony and its suitability for the rider. Conformation will not be considered. A Special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Adult and Junior Member of the S.S.A. carrying their current Championship Points Cards. **Hats to current British Safety standards or above must be worn for this class.**

BEST HORSE OR PONY RIDDEN SIDE SADDLE

Open to horses and ponies 4 years old or over: conformation & manners will be taken into consideration. At the Judge's discretion, horses/ponies may be stripped for conformation. Special rosette to the highest placed Adult and Junior Member of the S.S.A. carrying their current Championship Points Cards.

CONCOURS AND COSTUME CONCOURS d'ÉLÉGANCE CLASSES

- *The Judge must be on the current S.S.A. or any appropriate Judging panel but may be assisted by a Celebrity or Sponsor*
- *Where these classes are a main ring attraction Shows may, at their discretion limit entries to Adult competitors only and the rosette provided for the highest placed Junior will not be awarded.*

SIDE SADDLE CONCOURS d'ÉLÉGANCE

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of three or four riders to give short displays. 3 Special rosettes will be awarded: to the highest placed Adult rider wearing a silk hat, to the highest placed Adult rider wearing a bowler hat and the highest placed Junior member of the S.S.A. carrying their current Championship Points Cards. **N.B.** Silk hats are permitted to be worn by Adults IN THIS CLASS AT ANY TIME OF DAY. Juniors **must** wear hats to current British Safety standards or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk.

SIDE SADDLE COSTUME CONCOURS d'ÉLÉGANCE

The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse/pony and rider, and the way of going of the horse/pony. Safe tack must be used. Detailed inspection of the rider's period costume is not required. Fancy dress is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the judge may ask small groups of riders to give short displays. 2 Special rosettes to the highest placed Adult and Junior Members of the S.S.A. carrying their current Championship Points Cards. Competitors should produce a brief résumé about their costumes for the Commentator. Juniors **must** wear hats to current British Safety standards or above for this class. Adult riders not wearing such hats do so at their own risk.

WORKING HUNTER AND WORKING HUNTER PONY CLASSES

- *The Judge must be on the current S.S.A., SHBGB, BSHA, BSPS, or P(UK) Judging Panels*
- *These classes may be combined at the Show Organisers/Judge's discretion*
- *Hats to current British Safety standards or above must be worn for the jumping phase of these classes*

SIDE SADDLE OPEN WORKING HUNTER

Open to horses exceeding 148cms (14.2hh). Riders any age. Height of fences not to exceed 84cms (2'9"). The spread of fences shall not exceed the height. This class will be judged in accordance with SHBGB mark sheets.

SIDE SADDLE OPEN WORKING HUNTER PONY

Open to ponies not exceeding 153cms (15hh). Riders any age. Height of fences not to exceed 76cms (2'6"). If the class is split into height groups, ponies not exceeding 143cms (14hh), will jump a course not exceeding 69cms (2'3"), ponies not exceeding 133cms (13hh) a course not exceeding 61cms (2'). The spread of fences shall not exceed the height. A special rosette will be awarded to the highest placed 133cms and 143cms ponies. This class will be judged in accordance with BSPS mark sheets.

EQUITATION JUMPING CLASSES

- *The Judge must be on the current S.S.A. Judging Panel*
- *To be run under S.S.A. rules as they appear in the current Members' Handbook*
- *Hats to current British Safety standards or above must be worn for this class*
- *Junior riders are not permitted to wear a spur or spur band in any class where jumping is involved*
- *Shows may title their class(es) at their discretion, i.e. Open, Intermediate, Novice, Junior, Beginners etc., but may not exceed the appropriate heights or spreads stipulated below*
- *It is recommended that the first fence is built on the right rein towards the collecting ring*
- *The first two fences should not be maximum height*
- *A double should only be included in non Novice courses and should contain 2 non-jumping strides*

✚ EQUITATION JUMPING

Competitors may only compete once in any Equitation Jumping class, but may ride subsequent rounds, the National Side Saddle Show excepted, Hors Concours, on another horse or horses. To be run under S.S.A. rules as they appear in the current Members' Handbook. The course shall consist of 6 to 8 fences, rustic or coloured, or a combination of both. Maximum heights of fences: Junior Novice: Height 53cms (1'9") Spread 53cms (1'3"), Junior Open: Height 61cms (2'0") Spread 46cms (1'6"), Adult Novice: Height 61cms (2'0") Spread 46cms (1'6"), Adult Intermediate: Height 69cms (2'3") Spread 61cms (2'0"), Adult Open: Height 76cms (2'6") Spread 69cms (2'3").

3. **Letters in brackets after judge's names denote other judging panel(s) on which they are listed, subject to receipt of their Annual Return.**
4. R = Ride Judge for another Society's Panel.
5. Judges marked * are not eligible to take Probationary Judges.
6. All Judges are re-appointed annually and must attend a S.S.A. Seminar at least once every 3 years. **Failure to attend will result in the judge being removed from the list.**
