### **BSHA TRAINING CLASSES Not before 1-30pm**

These classes will take place at lunch time and Tim Price at Addington will have the viewing restaurant open so people can have a buffet lunch and sit and watch/learn.

**Judges: Ride: Mr Charles Le Moignan** a producer of top show horses and multiple winner of HOYS championships as many of you will know Charles always gets his horses going correctly, elegant hacks, forward going cobs - the right style and way of going for each class - take this opportunity to pick his brains and gain from his expertise.

**Conformation: Mrs Ali Fernyhough** has produced and ridden multiple winners of HOYS and RIHS Championships hacks, cobs, riding horses and hunters. Ali is a renown judge and trainer who has an amazing eye for spotting horses in 'the rough' this is your great opportunity to learn from Ali.

**In the Collecting Ring, Mr Simon Somers** will be available to give help and advice on Turn Out and suitability of tack.

### **Provisional Classes and Procedure**

**Class 8 - Riding Horses. Mare or Gelding** exceeding 148cms.

**Class 9 - Ridden Cobs (open to Maxi Cobs). Mare or Gelding** exceeding 148cms.

**Class 10 - Ridden Hacks. Mare or Gelding** exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms.

**Class 11 – Coloured Show Horse, Mare or Gelding** exceeding 148cms.

***Numbers in these classes will be limited so please make your entries early.***

The class will enter on the right rein, walk, trot, canter and extend (with the exception of hacks). The Judge will ride ALL the exhibits. The Judge on completion of the ride will give a brief critique on this and offer advice as to how to develop/improve this aspect. The Conformation Judge will give each exhibit advice on Type, Weight (in relation to Cobs), Blemishes etc. With regard to the Hack shows, both Judges will offer advice on the shows produced.

After the two Judges confer the class will walk a circle and the final line up will be pulled in and explanations offered by the two judges.

**By entering these inaugural BSHA Training Classes, exhibitors will undertake to accept the advice given in the spirit in which it is intended. Please also note that advice will be audible to fellow competitors and observers of the classes.**

**This is a UNIQUE chance to learn and develop one's showing knowledge in a way never previously offered. These classes are specifically aimed at those horses and riders who are not regularly qualifying for the major championship shows and who wish to improve.**
