4. Entries will be charged at a donation of £3.00 per competitor to cover administration fees. Once paid you may enter as many classes as you wish.
5. You must have permission from the owner to use each photograph. Watermarked or photographs with copyright will not be accepted.
6. You may submit photographs taken in any year; the combination of horse/rider does not need to be current.
7. All image entries to be sent to area12treasurer@outlook.com
8. Photographs should be submitted as a jpeg file, low res (min 300dpi is fine,) please avoid images over 3mb as these may not be accepted by the email server.
9. All entries should include class number, name of horse and the rider.

11. Entries in Class 7 will automatically qualify for The Jenny Childs Scholarship, which will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place prize winners.

Costume Concours

Class 1. Junior Rider (including LR riders). *To be judged on overall picture of elegance. Handler not to be taken into account.*

Class 2. Adult Rider. *To be judged on overall picture of elegance.*

Adult Equitation

Class 3. Newcomers Equitation. *Rider not to have competed in newcomers or equitation at the National Show, at the time the photograph was taken.*

Class 4. Novice Equitation. *Rider to be eligible for Novice Equitation at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Class 5. Intermediate Equitation. *Rider to be eligible for Intermediate Equitation at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Class 6. Open Equitation. *Rider to be eligible for Open Equitation at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Junior Equitation

Class 7*. Lead Rein and Young Rider. *Rider not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January 2020. Handler not to be taken into consideration.*

Class 8. Junior Novice Equitation. *Rider to be eligible for Junior Novice Equitation at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Class 9. Junior Open Equitation. *Rider to be eligible for Junior Open Equitation at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Best Horse & Pony

Class 10. Best Pony. *Confirmation and overall appearance of pony and rider to be considered*

Class 11. Best Horse. *Confirmation and overall appearance of horse and rider to be considered*

Adult Equitation Jumping

Class 12. Novice Equitation Jumping. *Rider to be eligible for Novice Equitation Jumping at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Class 13. Intermediate Equitation Jumping. *Rider to be eligible for Intermediate Equitation Jumping at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Class 14. Open Equitation Jumping. *Rider to be eligible for Open Equitation Jumping at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Junior Equitation Jumping

Class 15. Junior Novice Equitation Jumping. *Rider to be eligible for Junior Novice Equitation Jumping at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Class 16. Junior Open Equitation Jumping. *Rider to be eligible for Open Novice Equitation Jumping at time of photograph. (See Handbook for eligibility)*

Just for Fun

Class 17. Portrait in the style of Munnings. *Portrait of horse and rider, in the style of a Munnings portrait.*

Class 18. Pony and Pup. *Portrait of pony and dog, can be serious or fun, may include rider*

Class 19. Horse and Hound. *Portrait of horse and dog, can be serious or fun, may include rider*

NOTE : Class 7* : The **Jenny Childs Scholarship**, donated by **Jenny Childs**, will be awarded to **1st** (£75), **2nd** (£50) and **3rd** (£25) placed competitors towards side saddle training and/or saddle fitting.
